Winter camping is fun and challenging. For those few hardy souls who brave the freezing winter weather in just a tent, Simon Kenton Council offers the Polar Bear Camping Award!



The Polar Bear Camping Award is available to any registered Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Venturer and Scouter who meet the following requirements:

1. Plan an overnight at one of the council camps. (Camp Lazarus, Camp Falling Rock, Chief Logan Reservation, Camp Oyo, Camp Otter Run or Camp Madison Lake)
2. Experience sleeping in a tent, tarp, lean-to, or improved shelter in freezing weather (32° or below).
3. Boy Scouts should plan, cook, and prepare at least three meals (does not apply to Cub Scouts).
4. Two adult leaders must be in camp when the applicant is qualifying for the award. They are responsible for the health, safety and welfare of all participants.
5. Cub Scouts must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Cub Scout camping may occur at any time provided the proper clothing and equipment are available. All other Cub Scout camping requirements must be followed. Remember, for any Cub Scout camping program, a BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation) trained leader must be in attendance.
