

2017 Simon Kenton Council Canoe/Kayak Clinics

These special programs help your Scouts and your leaders develop their flatwater paddling, canoe tripping, and flatwater kayaking skills. Instructors are specialists in long canoe trips; nearly all are certified as ACA (American Canoe Association) instructors in canoe touring, canoeing, and/or kayaking.



Canoe MB Clinic teaches Scouts and Scouters paddling competency including all requirements for the Canoeing merit badge; serves as prerequisite for Trek Clinic.

Kayak MB Clinic teaches Scouts and Scouters all requirements for the Kayaking merit badge.

Trek Class teaches canoe-tripping skills, with an emphasis on preparation for Northern Tier or equivalent treks. Completion of the Canoe MB Clinic or equivalent paddling competence is a prerequisite.

Completion of the Canoe MB clinic authorizes Scouters to rent Council canoes for unit functions. Clinics fill up quickly so be sure to register early. In addition to individuals, Troops or Crews are welcome to sign up as a group as their monthly camping activity. To sign up, you must be a Boy Scout or Venturer. BSA rules do not allow Cub Scouts to be in a boat other than as a passenger. All Participants must have passed the BSA Swimmer's Test within the last year.
