2017 Rappelling Clinic



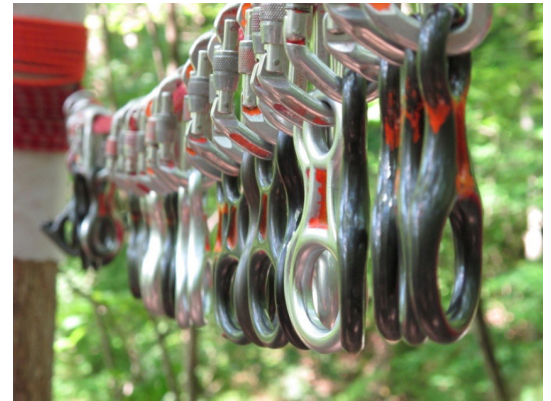
What: Rappelling Clinic - a weekend training clinic combining rappelling skills with fun & fellowship.
Rappel Master* - an individual qualified to lead his/her unit on rappelling outings.
* to qualify as a Rappel Master one must pass the intern portion of the program.

When: May 19-21 and September 15-17, 2017
Both weekends: 7pm Friday - 3pm Sunday

Who: Scouts (14 and older), BSA & Non-BSA Adults & Troop Leadership.

Why: The objectives of the Rappelling Clinic are:
1.) to help young scouts and novices learn safe and proper rappelling techniques.
2.) to qualify the more experienced participants as Rappel Masters.



Costs: Costs include food, lodging & program materials. All first time attendees receive a locking D-Ring, a Rappelling Course Manual, 20' of Webbing, 5' & 9' Sections of Prusik Line & a Patch.

What To Pack: Participants should dress as the weather dictates and wear tight fitting clothes and a belt. Lodging and bunks will be provided; however, participants will need to supply their own bedding. You may also bring your own tent for housing.

All adult attendees must have Youth Protection Training. No Exceptions.
