The Wood Badge Scholarship Fund exists to support those Scouters who wish to attend Wood Badge training and have a financial need. Other generous Scouters make these funds available to the Committee in the hope that those assisted will continue their efforts to improve the Scouting program. The Committee has limited funds, so it asks all individuals to first consider other possible sources of support such as units, chartered organizations, or employers. If sufficient funds are not available to you, the Committee will review your application. Scholarships are limited to a maximum of \$120 with three conditions:

- Scholarships are only available to courses currently open for registration
- You are a currently registered Scouter in good standing with current Youth Protection Training
- You contribute at least \$120 to the course fee prior to receiving a Scholarship
