# Nominating Committee Purpose

"A district committee is responsible for increasing the effectiveness of Scouting throughout a district through the achievement of district goals.

The district nominating committee is responsible for selecting a slate of competent officers and members at large for the next year is an extremely important one." - [District Nominating Committee Worksheet](#)

- Review Qualifications
  - People
  - Positions
- Study Participation & Performance of previous years officers & members at large
  - Officers include- District Chair, Vice Chairs (Finance, Membership Program)
- Make suggestions for each officer and member at large, matching skills to needs, and participate in committee effort to reach unanimous agreement on each nominee
- Participate as requested in personally contacting each nominee and securing agreement to serve. This step and the plans for recruitment are vital to the process. Use Selecting District People, No. 34512, as a guide.
- Support fully the final action of the committee
- Treat all information as confidential.

## “Why” Nominating Committee

- Expand Scouting into and around local communities through use of business networks not available to the traditional Scouting community
- Increase Council brand awareness with local business & business leaders
- Increase Council brand awareness with Communities, leaders & organizations
- Grow the district teams with new members annually
  - Non-profit campaigns plan on 80% renewal annually
  - 20%** new members needed for annual growth
- Unbiased analysis of current officers and members at large
- Council Bylaws – Article VIII, section 4  
“...three to five names of a potential district nominating committee shall be submitted to the [Council] President for approval. The President has the discretion to add or delete names for the nominating committee from the Executive Board or the community at large.”

## “How” Nominating Committee’s are formed

- Prospected by Current Scouters
- Bio’s can be submitted from District Chairs
- Bio’s can be submitted from Professional Scouters
- Nominating committee members and chairs can be appointed by the Council President
- Nominations for nominating committee can be submitted to district leadership from local community leaders, organization as well as business leaders and organizations.
- All members are subject to approval by the Council President


- Ample TAY, limited schools access issues


