Adult Leader Recommended Qualifications for the 2023 National Scout Jamboree

There are several key requirements for each of the 2 Scouts BSA Troop contingent leader positions (6) and the 1 Venturing Crew contingent leader positions (2) which are detailed below.

A fundamental requirement is the willingness and ability to dedicate significant time and effort to recruit youth participants and prepare the contingent for the Jamboree.

Monthly meetings and several weekend orientations, participant training and youth leader training sessions will be conducted in order to insure that the contingent is prepared for an experience of a lifetime. Additionally, communications, logistics, equipment planning and project management are important factors.

In addition to the position specific requirements the general requirements are:

All Adult Leaders

- Must have a current BSA membership in a local council unit.
- All leaders, regardless of assigned position, must be at least 21 years of age by 7/19/2023.
- Be approved by the local council.
- Have completed Youth Protection Training (Y01) within one year of the first day of the Jamboree.
- Completed and have current credentials in all of the following as of 7/19/2023. Weather Hazards (SCO_800). For SM/ ASM positions Scoutmaster Specific (S24 or online equivalent), Outdoor Leader Skills (S11) and Wood Badge training (A90) are required. (Older training courses prior to 1/1/2000 are not acceptable).
- All adults must register online through the Jamboree registration system as a "Leader". The council will designate specific leadership or chaperone positions at the time the Jamboree units are assigned.
- Have participated in the pre-jamboree training experience.
- Submitted BSA Annual Health & Medical Record using the on-line Jamboree submission process. The AHMR must be dated on or after July 29, 2022.
- Submit all registration fees per the local council's payment schedule.
- The Unit Care Provider must be one of the Unit Leaders (SM/ASM/Advisor) and is required to hold either current Wilderness First Aid and CPR certificates or a current healthcare license (MD, DO, APRN, RN, PA, Paramedic, EMT). This unit leader's responsibilities include providing for the safety and well-being of each unit member.

Scoutmaster (2 positions)

- Be registered & serve as a Unit Leader (Scoutmaster/ Advisor/ Skipper) for at least one year & an active Unit Leader or Ass't. Unit Leader for the remaining time during the three-year period prior to 7/19/2023.
- Have served as an Assistant Scoutmaster for a prior Jamboree contingent (*preferred*).

First Assistant Scoutmaster (Troop Activities) (2 positions)

- Be registered and serve as an active adult leader for a troop for at least the 3 year period prior to 7/19/2023.

Second Assistant Scoutmaster (Physical Arrangements) (2 positions)

- Be registered and serve as an active adult leader.

Third Assistant Scoutmaster (Scheduling and Records) (2 positions)

- Be registered and serve as an active adult leader.

Venturing Crew Advisor (2 positions)

- Be registered and serve as a Crew Advisor, Skipper, Associate Advisor or Mate for the 3 year period prior to 7/19/2023. Have completed New Venturing Leader Specific training (P21 or online equivalent after 1/1/2015) and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (S11). Wood Badge (A90) is preferred.
