Simon Kenton Council 2023 National Scout Jamboree





Simon Kenton Council plans on sending two Scouts BSA Troops and one Venturing Crew to the 2023 National Scout Jamboree at the Summit Bechtel Reserve in West Virginia. Male and female participants will be separated into different contingent units.

National Jamborees occur once every four years and are your opportunity to see the Scouting movement on the National and International stage. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity to join 15,000 Scouts for 10 days of high adventure activities, stadium shows, meeting new friends, patch trading, adventure sports, interacting with international Scouts, sub camp & base camp bashes and much more. Councils from around the country send contingent Scouts BSA Troops consisting of 36 youth, and 4 adult leaders.

Interest is always high in attending Jamborees, don't hesitate - apply today!!!

Youth & Young Adult Participant Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a registered member of the BSA in one of the following programs: Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scouting, or Exploring.
- Age Requirements & Limitations:
 - Youth Participant: MUST be at least 12 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree but not reached their 18th birthday by the last day of the Jamboree. Completing Scouts BSA First Class rank is highly recommended.
 - Young Adult Participant: MUST be at least 18 years old by July 19, 2023 but not yet 21 by July 28, 2023.
 MUST be housed as an adult due to chronological age, while allowed to participate in the program with youth participants.
- Be approved by the unit leader and local council.
- MUST have appropriate parent/guardian complete the online parental consent. (An email will be sent to the parent/guardian during the national council application process.)
- Participate in pre-Jamboree training experience with local council and unit leader.
- Submitted BSA Annual Health & Medical Record using the on-line Jamboree submission process. The AHMR must be dated on or after July 29, 2022.
- Complete payment of registrations fees prior to departure for the Jamboree.

Cost and Payment Schedule:

The total early bird cost (payments started to SKC prior to 10/31/2022) for each participant is \$1,800. An initial payment made after the early bird deadline results in a participant cost of \$2,015. The early-bird participant fee increase is a BSA National Council requirement. Both costs are subject to change if there are significant increases in transportation fuel costs or trip expenses. The cost includes transportation, special patches, patrol and troop equipment, duffel bag & day pack, and Jamboree training outings/meetings. When National Scholarships become available the scholarship form will be posted. Deposits are non-refundable unless a wait-listed participant can take your slot.
