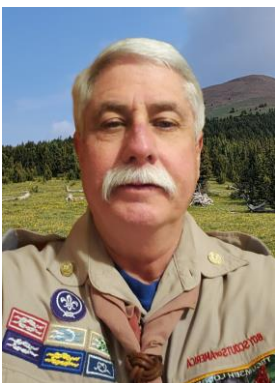

Need financial assistance? A link to the scholarship application is included on the registration page or you can contact the course director.

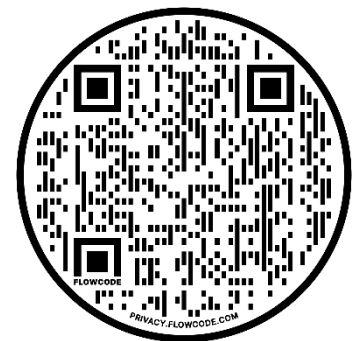
Qualifications:
